

Local Transportation Options from Airport to Hotel in Halifax

- 1. Halifax Metro transit (city bus) has a bus that runs on a fixed schedule to and from the airport. It drops people off on the street behind the Delta Halifax. The cost is \$3.50 and it takes about one hour. For schedule: http://www.halifax.ca/metrotransit/Schedules/documents/Route320.pdf
- There is now a shuttle bus operating to and from the airport. It runs from the airport directly to Delta Halifax. It costs \$34 return (half that one way). About 30min ride Website for schedule and pre-pay http://www.maritimebus.com/en/
- 3. There is always the option of taxi. There is no additional fee to share a cab. Taxis are **\$63** one way. Taxis leaving from the airport do not need to be booked ahead. There is a taxi stand outside the arrival doors at the airport. It might be best for working group members heading to the airport on Friday afternoon to share a cab as it will be quicker than the bus.
